Dear Quilters,

Our meeting will be this Thursday, 6:00 pm at the Extension Office - barring any closures from the Extension Office. We will have a lesson on English Paper Piecing from Nadine Cox, Shelbyville. She has done a lot of this style of piecing and will have some really beautiful examples to show. She has been doing this for a number of years because I remember her bringing her "kit" when we went to KHQS meetings! She has asked us to bring the following items to our meeting:

- 6 4" squares of one fabric
- 1 4" square of contrast or coordinating fabric
- Needle, thread, thimble, 1 or 2 long ball top pins, thread clipping scissors
- Binding clip or paper clip
- Sandwich box for keeping your project
- Paper and pin for notes

We will also be doing a Christmas block challenge due at the Christmas meeting. You will receive a packet of fabric at the meeting, with which you can make as many 12 1/2" unfinished quilt blocks as you can get out of the package. You may not use any other material, making any block patterns you want! For each block you turn in, in December, you will receive a ticket (the more blocks you turn in, the more coupons you receive). The more blocks that are made and turned in, the more people that will be able to participate in this drawing. Realize that everyone's name will be drawn. Your name will be drawn only once, and you have to be present to choose blocks from all of those turned in. You will receive 12 blocks, enough for a quilt top, for you to put together. I have participated in this project and really found some beautiful blocks I would never thought of making with these fabrics! It is a challenge to see how many blocks you can get out of this fabric package! I will have examples of some blocks so you can see a few of the amazing possibilities. More explanations at the meeting! The packet includes 3 fat quarters of a Christmas theme and 1 1/4 yard, width of fabric, for background fabric in the same line of fabric. The packet will cost \$2.00 - yes, you saw it correct! \$2.00 per packet, a real deal for beautiful Christmas fabric! There should be about 27 packets, first come first served basis. If you won't be at the meeting and want to participate in this fun Christmas project, be sure and call me to reserve you a packet.

We will need to wear masks for this meeting, as well as social distance. Kay Scheffler, and Mable Crain have both been hospitalized for Covid, and pneumonia, Kay now home. Also, Joan is finally home, on oxygen, and slowly recovering. as well as Pat Miller. More details at the meeting.
