GENERAL RULES APPLYING TO ALL 4-H EXHIBITORS

1. Eligibility
 - a. Clover Bud classes are for 4-H youth ages 5-8 (see Clover Bud section under trends); a Clover Bud may enter up to 2 projects in each Clover Bud category.
 - b. Junior classes are for 4-H youth ages 9-13 as of January 1, 2025
 - c. Senior classes are for 4-H youth ages 14-18 as of January 1, 2025
2. All projects, unless otherwise specified must have been made since the last County Fair.
3. Residence—the 4-H Club Division is open only to youth residing in Anderson County
4. Exhibitors must follow the guidelines and requirements of the specific category
5. The number of entries per division or class are outlined in each section and vary for each division
6. All junior and senior exhibitors may enter up to TWO items per division in the “other” category. These items will not be eligible to go on to the State Fair (see “Other” section).
7. All items must be family friendly
8. Premiums will be awarded as available
9. Projects are cared for and protected to the best of our abilities, but occasionally items get damaged, lost or stolen. You are entering your exhibits at your own risk.
