

#### Class Skill Levels

**Beginner:** Those who may be a first time student with little or no experience.

*Intermediate*: Those who are knowledgeable in a craft but are limited in experience.

**Advanced:** Recommended for those who have knowledge of the project and have had completed similar projects in the past with little assistance.

**All Levels:** Skill level can range from Beginner to Advanced.

- Some classes teach the basic steps, and you may not complete a finished product in class.
- For projects requiring a glue gun please bring a protective holder for the glue gun.

#### Sewing Classes:

Make sure sewing machine has a power cord, foot control, owner's manual, extra needles, and is in good working condition. Basic sewing kit includes scissors, seam ripper, tape measure, straight pins, and any other sewing tools that you normally use.

Class # 1 Table Runner: Four Fabric Pieces, Four Seams

**<u>Description</u>**: Participants will sew a 40" long x 13 1/2 " wide table runner using only four fabric pieces and four seams. MUST be able to sew ½" seams.

<u>Supplies Needed</u>: (2)-2 1/2" WOF-width of fabric (flange); (1)-10" WOF (center); (1)-18" WOF (backing); sewing machine, thread, scissors, basic notions. Must come to class with

fabric pieces cut according to supply list.
