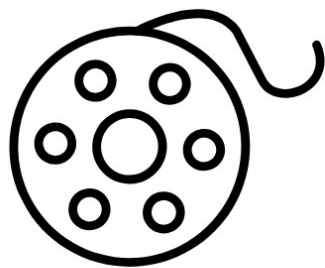




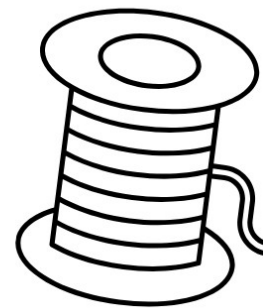

Class Skill Levels

Beginner: *Must be able to thread sewing machine and wind bobbin(s). Must have knowledge of sewing terms, be able to read a pattern, and be capable of performing basic machine techniques.*

Intermediate: *Must have good command of sewing skills, knowledge and operation of sewing machine or serger and sewing techniques and be able to read and follow pattern instructions without assistance.*

Advanced: *Must be proficient at most sewing techniques in the subject area, including knowledge of your machine and using many sewing machine features.*

Basic Machine Sewing Supply List

Individual class supply lists will be separate.

- ◆ Sewing machine in good working order, with manual, power cord and foot pedal)
- ◆ Serger, if applicable to your class, with manual, power cord, and foot pedal
- ◆ Extra machine needles in different sizes, bobbins, extra bulb, and required machine feet
- ◆ Extension cord and/or power strip
- ◆ Rotary mat, rotary cutter, extra blades, and ruler(s) if applicable to your class
- ◆ Fabric shears, paper scissors, thread clippers, seam ripper, and other sewing notions as needed
- ◆ Straight pins and pin cushion
- ◆ Pencils and fabric markers for dark and light fabric
- ◆ Thread
- ◆ Paper and pen for taking notes
- ◆ Baggies for keeping track of project pieces
- ◆ Irons and ironing boards will be provided on-site

Two Day Classes

Maple Leaf Flurries Quilt *Intermediate Skill Level*

Are you intimidated by foundation paper piecing? Maple Leaf Flurries is a beginner pattern from Judy Niemeyer at Quiltworx. This simple pattern makes a 42" x 42" wall-hanging from just three colors of fabric. All foundation papers and comprehensive directions with a color layout are included in the class. Extra foundation papers are available if a larger quilt is desired. No previous paper piecing experience is necessary, but helpful. Participants will learn to cut out foundation papers and templates. Participants will use templates to cut out fabrics and learn how to organize fabrics for easier sewing.

Participants will learn to sew on foundation papers and how to correctly trim and add each subsequent piece of fabric. Participants should be able to complete 8 units or more. In class instruction will be given on joining the units and completing the quilt top. This information is also included in the written directions.

Supplies to Bring: Basic sewing supplies and sewing machine Travel iron and mat Rotary cutter and mat 6" x 24" ruler Open toe and quarter inch foot for your sewing machine 12" Add-a Quarter ruler Fabric Glue pen (like Fons and Porter or Sewline) Clear water-soluble glue stick Paper Scissors 3 zip and lock type gallon size bags Sewing thread to match fabric Light box (optional) Fabric (at least 42" wide) to make whole quilt 1½ yards light for background (white, beige or light-colored fabric) 1 yard medium 1 yard dark 3 yards for backing, binding and border (This can be the same fabric as the medium or the dark. So then 4 yards of fabric is needed of that fabric if you chose that option.)

Constructing a Tiered Skirt *Intermediate Skill Level*

Whether it's boho chic, casual or dressed up, the tiered skirt has been around for a long time and continues to be a popular style of clothing that can be easily created to fit individual sizes and shapes. Techniques in this class will include using a ruffler foot, inserting elastic, and seaming with a serger (sergers will be available for use). Portion will determine billowy-ness effect or how much 'swing' in your skirt!

Supplies to Bring: Bring sewing machine with foot control and instruction booklet; serger if possible; basic sewing supplies to include tape measure, marking pen, fabric shears and other sewing supplies. This skirt will be constructed in layers. The skirt may be all one color or mixed colors. there will be 3 tiers plus an elastic casing. Bring sewing thread that coordinates; neutral serger threads; 1 yard of 1 inch wide elastic; For 45 inch wide fabric in one color: Small-medium 3 yards; large- xlarge 4 yards For multi color layers: 1st & 2nd layers; Smallmedium 1 1/3 yard each; Large- Xlarge 1 1/2 yard each 3rd layer; Smallmedium 1 1/2 yard; Large-Xlarge 1 3/4 yard 4th layer; Small-medium 1 3/4 yard; Large-Xlarge 2 yards If wanting to make your skirt longer than 34 inches add 1/2 yard to each amount. Fabrics should be soft cotton, challis, silk-like fabrics, or blends. Fabric should be pre-washed before class.

Sew Demented Organizer *Intermediate Skill Levels*

We will make the Sew Together Organizer by Sew Demented. This fourcompartment organizer is great for traveling with sewing and quilting supplies, toiletries, pencil cases, etc. This is four-hour class. Purchase of pattern included with the class fee.

Supplies to Bring: • Exterior fabric: 1 fat quarter (18" x 22") • Lining Fabric: 1/2 yard x WOF • Pocket Lining: 1/3 yard x WOF • Binding fabric: 1 fat quarter (18" x 22") Project preparation that must be complete prior to the class (i.e cut fabric):: 1. FROM EXTERIOR FABRIC: Add any embellishment to exterior before trimming to size • Cut exterior - 13½" x 9¾" Tip: for directional fabric, cut 2 panels 7" x 9¾" and seam along the 9¾" edge. • Cut 2 side panels using pattern piece, make sure you cut it on the fold! 2. FROM LINING FABRIC: • Cut B1, B2, B3, and B4 - 8¾" x 9¾" (four pieces) • Cut 2 side panels using pattern piece, make sure you cut it on the fold! 3. FROM POCKET LINING FABRIC: • Cut 6 rectangles 4" x 9¾" 4. FROM BINDING FABRIC: • Cut 2 strips 2¼" x 15" – for side bindings • Cut 2 strips 2¼" x 20" – for exterior zipper binding • Cut 2 strips 1¾" x 6" – for zipper tabs

Crumb Quilt Block *All Skill Levels*

Learn how to make a 10 x 10 inch "crumb" quilt block using scrap pieces of fabric. No pattern or plan ahead necessary to do this free flow, no stress, way of quilting. Utilize all those leftover "scraps" from other projects, rather than throwing them away.

Supplies to Bring: Supply list: 10 or 12-inch square quilting ruler, (some will be available for you to use.) Bring basic sewing notions, thread and bobbins, rotary cutter (a few will be available for use), extra machine needles. Sewing machine that you know how to operate. Irons will be available for use, if you have a small iron you wish to bring and setup next to your machine, feel free to.

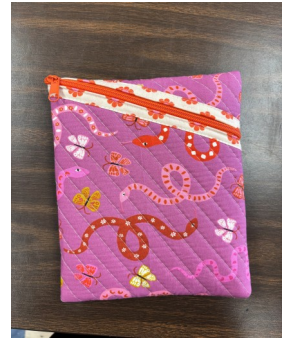
Hemingway Pouch *Beginner Skill Levels*

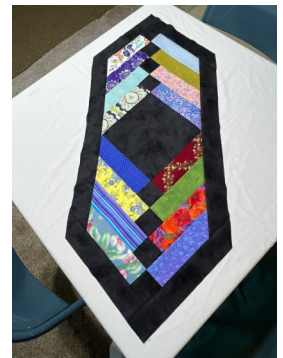
Table Runner *Beginner Skill Levels*
